### **Action Plans**

Formation of a Spanish programme (deferred)

- a. Committee formed to explore the idea in December 2020. DONE
- b. Launching initial short course (Análisis Eschatológico) to trial this and gather information regarding viability and interest, to be held in November 2021, and discuss results.

- c. Launching further Spanish short courses to explore continued interest.

- d. Full formation of Spanish programme is on hold until appropriate Spanish-speaking staff are involved.

#### Relaunch of Onsite Programme (in progress)

- a. In December 2022, serious discussion among staff began regarding resuming onsite programme.
- b. School board met to discuss future programmes in January 2023. The decision was made to continue the distance learning programme, and to plan for onsite courses to resume in August 2024.
- c. Re-develop and advertise the onsite programme. Building upgrades and maintenance necessary for onsite accommodation. ONGOING
